



ACADEMIC AND ARTS SCHOLARSHIPS 2017



Each year, the Rotary Club of Haddonfield Foundation provides financial assistance to accomplished students with financial need in Haddonfield and nearby communities who are planning to further their education in a university, college, vocational, or other tertiary setting.

The Foundation is incorporated as a New Jersey nonprofit corporation operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes. Since making its first awards in 2002, the Foundation has awarded 95 scholarships with a total value of \$175,000.

It is anticipated that at least six academic and arts scholarships, each valued at \$2,000, will be awarded in April 2017. Applications from qualified students are invited.

Each year, the Rotary Club of Haddonfield Foundation provides financial assistance to deserving students in Haddonfield and nearby communities who are planning to further their education in a university, college, vocational, or other tertiary setting. It is anticipated that at least six Academic and Arts scholarships, each valued at \$2,000 and payable to the institution the recipient attends, will be awarded in April 2017.

Academic Scholarships are awarded based on academic achievement, recommendations, evidence of motivation, character, ability, work experience and the required essay. Arts Scholarships are awarded based on achievement in the arts, potential for success in the arts, and the required essay. An audition may be required.

Particular consideration will be given to students who demonstrate an understanding of the Mission of Rotary International: providing service to others, promoting high ethical standards, and advancing world understanding, goodwill, and peace.

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INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

NOTE: INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

1. ENSURE that you are eligible. If you are a member of the Rotary Club of Haddonfield, or a close relative of a member, or a substantial contributor to the Rotary Club of Haddonfield Foundation, you are not eligible to receive a scholarship. 2. COMPLETE the Scholarship Application form (page 3).
3. SUBMIT an evaluation from a teacher, instructor, counselor, or principal at your high school. If a Teacher Evaluation form from the Common Application for Undergraduate College Admission (or the Instructor Recommendation form from the Universal College Application) was submitted as part of a college application, you may include a copy of that form with your application. If the evaluator wishes to send the form directly, the address is: Scholarship Committee, Rotary Club of Haddonfield Foundation, PO Box 383, Haddonfield, NJ 08033. If you need to obtain an evaluation, ask the evaluator to use the Teacher Evaluation form on the Common Application website:

4. In an essay, DISCUSS how your education beyond high school will help you to achieve the goals you have set for yourself. Your essay should be no longer than two double-spaced, typed pages. Put your name at the top right of each page. SUBMIT your essay with the Scholarship Application form.
5. SUBMIT the first page of your FAFSA form, showing the Expected Family Contribution towards your tuition.
6. SIGN the Declarations (Page 4). ENSURE that your parents/guardians sign as well.
7. COPY your application and attachments for your own records.
8. MAIL your application – postmarked on or before **WEDNESDAY, MARCH 15, 2017** – to: Scholarship Committee, Rotary Club of Haddonfield Foundation, PO Box 383, Haddonfield, NJ 08033.

NOTE: If you are awarded a scholarship, you must attend the awards presentation, held during a Rotary dinner at the Tavistock Country Club on Sunday, April 23, 2017. Two guests (typically parents or guardians) are welcome to attend with you. If you are the recipient of an Academic Scholarship you may be asked to read the essay you submitted with your application. If you are a recipient of an Arts Scholarship, you may be asked to perform (one piece, four minutes maximum).
