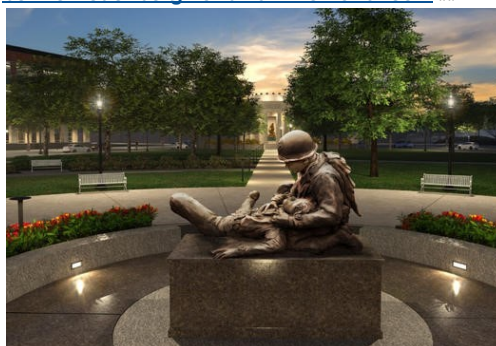
Event chairperson Rotarian Ralph Cooper reported that over 2-dozen donors participated during the session and that the Red Cross was please with the turn-out.
