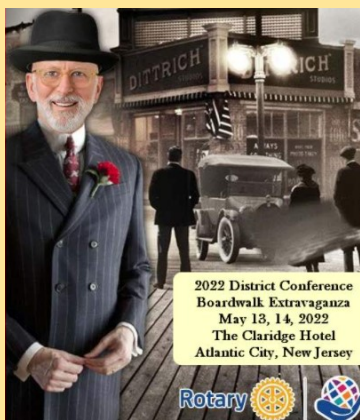

This April 28th OCUT Rotary meeting will be held at Uncle Bill's Pancake House, 2112 Asbury Ave., Ocean City.

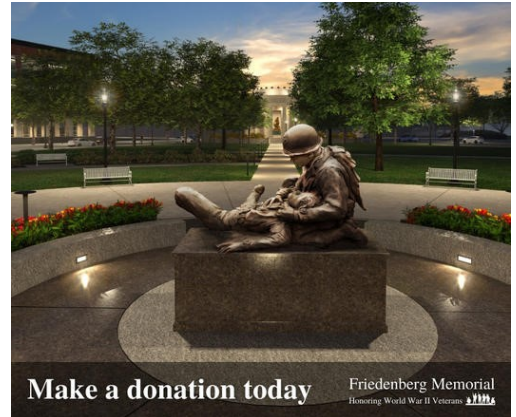
Retired FBI Special Agent Robert Turkavage, of Brigantine, will give a presentation about the project to build and install a bronze statue of staff sergeant cradling a wounded soldier in his arms on Omaha Beach on D-Day, June 6, 1944.

Future Rotary Programs:

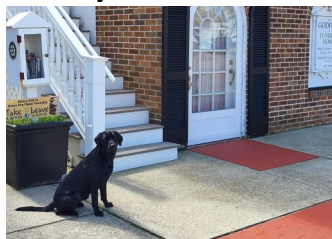
