Joe Martucci, Press of Atlantic City Meteorologist

Rotary Club OC-UT May 28th Online Program

The Rotary Club of Ocean City - Upper Township online program for Thursday, May 28, 2020, will be Joe Martucci, The Press of Atlantic City meteorologist.

Martucci is a Rutgers University graduate and according to his web page "<u>Meet</u> <u>Joe Martucci</u>" he loves anything Rutgers, from the Meteorology Program to his football season tickets.

Living in a region with a rich shore and agricultural history, Martucci says he is keenly aware of the impact weather has on tourism and the economy.

Martucci has led all weather operations at The Press of Atlantic City since the Fall of 2017 and his passion to keep residents and visitors aware of what's next for the weather has been recognized by the New Jersey Press Association, where he is a five time award winner.

His commitment to being highly visible in the community led to being named a Top 40 Under 40 by Atlantic City Weekly in 2020.

Martucci is proud of his work and notes that "the Press is your home for South Jersey Weather." He broadcasts the full mainland and shore forecast, year-round through internet video three times daily and is the only media outlet to do that for the region. A written daily weather column is provided both online and in print, 7 days a week.

Check out his "**Something in the Air**" weather podcast page, which is updated on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday each month. There is also a monthly weather recap with New Jersey State Climatologist Dr. Dave Robinson.

In his free time, Martucci enjoys being out on the ice at the Flyers Skate Zone in Atlantic City. He combines his love of people and hockey as a Board Member for the Art Dorrington Foundation, keeping kids "on the streets, off the ice".

Following his presentation, Martucci will answer questions that have been submit-

ted online prior to the meeting. He hopes to cover as many as time will permit.
