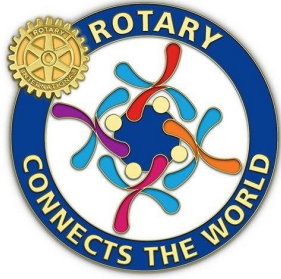

The Ocean City-Upper Twp. Rotary Club is donating ten (10) video/audio baby monitors to the Shore Medical Center in Somers Point, NJ.

James Chadwick, President, Rotary Club of Ocean City-Upper Township, had contacted Tami Kitchen at Shore Medical Center after the facility's request for monitors, to aid in observation and communication with patients in isolation, was seen by Club members over the weekend.

Chadwick noted that all the monitors have two-way talk and night vision. The shipment is to be delivered to the hospital April 10<sup>th</sup>. "We hope this delivery, in addition to other donations you have likely received, will be sufficient to aid your staff in the necessary observation and communication with those in isolation rooms, and enable you to do so in a safe manner so as to restrict your exposure to COVID-19 or other contagions that you may have to address in the future," President Chadwick said.

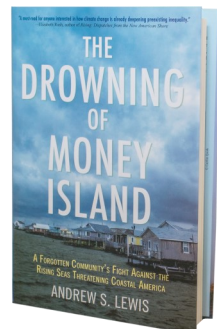
