

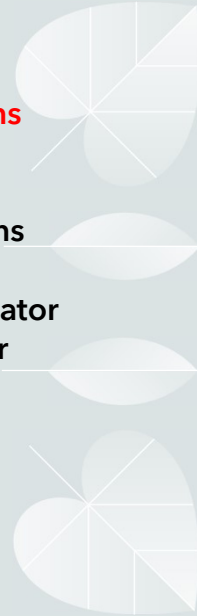

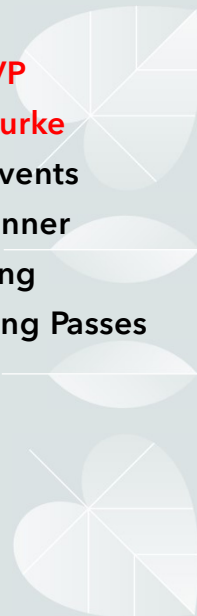

## Steps to Propose a New Member

This process can take anywhere from four to eight weeks.

- **First:** Invite a potential Rotarian to lunch
- **Second:** If interested, have the potential member complete a Membership Application (forward to Membership Chair)
- **Third:** Potential member must attend at least two lunch meetings before their name is announced to the membership.
- **Fourth:** Potential member's name will be posted in the club's newsletter for two weeks.
- **Fifth:** If there have been no objections to the potential member's membership, it is then put on the Board's agenda for final approval. (The Membership Committee tries to move potential members along through this possible and can request a Board email vote earlier than the BOD meeting is scheduled).
- **Sixth:** Welcome letter is sent to the proposed member which includes dues information. The dues and initial membership fee must be paid before the new member is inducted.
- **Seventh:** Treasurer will notify Membership Chair payment has been received at which time the Chair will schedule the new members Induction.
- **Eighth:** Once inducted, new Rotarian will be asked to do a Classification Talk.
