Rotary International is made up of over 1.2 million members worldwide, all subscribing to the ideal of **SERVICE ABOVE SELF**. The object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise. In addition to other scholarships awarded by Rotary International, the Scarborough Rotary Club is excited to offer this local scholarship to graduating seniors who have found their own way of contributing to their communities by fostering the ideals of service, volunteerism, high ethical standards, and the overall values of Rotary International.

Eligibility:

The following is a list of eligibility requirements that any applicant must meet before being considered for this award. A qualified applicant must:

- 1. Be a full time resident of the town of Scarborough, Maine.
- 2. Be a graduating senior in good academic standing (2.5 GPA or higher) from an accredited school or home school.
- 3. Have been accepted to a certificate or degree program at an accredited institution for post secondary education following graduation.
- 4. Submit a complete application by the application deadline.
- 5. Not be an immediate family member of a current or former Rotarian in the Scarborough Rotary Club. Immediate family member shall be defined as a student living within the same household.

Selection Process:

Selections will be made by the scholarship committee of the Scarborough Rotary Club. The committee is made up of a chairperson and members appointed by the club president. The final number and financial amount of each award will be determined by the scholarship committee and may vary from year to year.

Award Requirements:

In order to receive funds from an award, recipients must notify the treasurer of the Scarborough Rotary Club upon completion of their first semester of school following graduation. A transcript demonstrating the student has earned a GPA of 2.5 or greater while in a full-time status (as defined by the school) will be required before funds are released. It is becoming increasingly popular for students to take a "gap" year or other time off after

graduating high school. Students electing to take time off before continuing their education will not be eligible for funds until they have completed one semester of schooling. It is highly recommended that any student planning on taking time off from school contact an officer of the Rotary Club as soon as reasonably possible to avoid forfeiting their award. Additionally, any awards granted to students have an expiration date of two years from the time of graduation even if portions of the award have already been issued.
