- March 27 *Purpose Connector* Leaders know how to connect to their unique passions and mission, so they can align their talent and strengths to help their organizations thrive. This workshop provides interactive exercises that will connect you with your purpose. Leaders that know why they are leading are more effective.
- April 24 *Time and Productivity Tools This workshop examines 3 Skills, 3 Principles, 3 Techniques, and 3 Corollaries that impact your productivity and profitability. Walk away with increased focus and action plans to accomplish what you desire.*
- May 22 Communication the Power of Expectations Workshop introduces a process to build trust and increase communication when working with clients, team members, staff, volunteers. Create a working social contract to build ever more powerful relationships with deep levels of trust.
- June 19 *Processing to Achieve Success* Workshop focus on how to foster and supply continuous feedback that will assist you as a leader in growing your relationships, personal development, and team productivity.
