Funds are maintained at The Columbus Foundation. Funds for these life- changing projects are raised through Dublin AM Rotary Community fund-raisers and contributions from individuals and corporations.

The Dublin AM Charitable Foundation gratefully accepts individual donations. One-time donations as well as beneficiary donations are used to increase the foundation endowment and the group's ability to offer community grants.

Dublin AM Rotary club members have created two community events where members, friends and neighbors can enjoy themselves and raise money for the foundation:

- · Pro Am Event at the Muirfield Memorial Tournament
- · Polar Bear Golf Open, an opportunity to golf in February in Ohio

Both events are supported through tickets sales as well as individual and corporate sponsors. All monies raised directly benefit the foundation. Each year the Foundation board meets to review grant requests from both the club and outside groups.

In the 30 plus years of service to the community, the Dublin AM Charitable Foundation has provided over \$1,000,000 in grants. Those grants include support for:
