



- Central and Southeast Ohio has numerous veterans, Veterans Service Organizations (VSO's) and small independent groups seeking and providing some type of assistance and support to area veterans.
- While well-intended, this support and assistance is often insufficient, overlapping, duplicative, or competing
 for limited available dollars or resources.
- As a community service outreach, Rotary District 6690 has formed a Veteran's Affairs Committee (VAC) to
 provide an additional and established network to area veterans seeking support with housing, care, and
 assistance on identified needs following their military service.
- District 6690 VAC's will utilize their presence and availability of Rotary clubs within the district's Central and Southeastern Ohio area to provide a means of communication, coordination, and collaboration on veteran assistance programs available through federal, state, and local resources within this operating area.
- A key project and program for District 6690 Rotary clubs will be the VetWork Ohio project. This project seeks to develop a centralized collaboration facility that will provide for coordination, communication, and information-sharing for veteran's programs, projects, and activities existing and available within Central and Southeast Ohio. The project vision is to build a network of VSO's, veterans, and volunteers that extends throughout the area to provide for long-term economic and societal services beneficial to veterans and their community areas. Rotary's presence and involvement in these communities will enhance the opportunities to better reach and serve deserving veterans.
