The Highland Village Rotary Club has scheduled our annual Four Way Test Speech Contest for February 23, 2012. The contest is designed to:

- Acquaint a large number of youth with Rotary and the 4 Way Test.
- Demonstrate and enhance Rotary's commitment to youth.
- Heighten awareness of Rotary among youth, parents, schools and community.
- Recognize, encourage and reward hard work and accomplishment of youth.

Highland Village Rotary Club will award three prizes, 1st - \$200; 2nd - \$100; 3rd - \$50. The first place winner will advance to the Rotary Area Competition scheduled for March 31, 2012 location TBD. The final competitions will be held at the District 5790 Conference on May 19, 2012 in Fort Worth.

Contest rules are:

- Public, private and continuation high school students in grades 9 through 12 are eligible to enter the contest.
- Speeches must be between 5 and 7 minutes in length.
- The theme for 2011-2012 Rotary International is "The Future of Rotary is in Your Hands" which can also be the theme for this year's Speech Contest. The topic of the speech must be specifically subjected to the Four-Way Test. This must be done in the body of the speech and is not to be reserved for concluding statements only.
- Contestants will be judged on February 23, 2012 at Johnny G's American Grill in Lewisville.

SPRING 2012 Rotary District 5790 FOUR-WAY SPEECH CONTEST RULES

- 1. Contestants must be students from the 9th through 12th grade (public, private or home school)
- 2. The subject of "What the 4-Way Test Means to Me" should be closely followed.

Material must be original in content and be about applying the Rotary Four Way Test to an important issue in our everyday relationships with other people. Contestants should write a speech with facts, statistics, stories, examples, and quotations. Add some humor and personal touches, but do not mention your name, school or city or the location of your sponsoring Rotary Club. - 3. Written Scripts are not allowed; 3 x 5 cards may be used;
- 4. No props of any kind will be allowed.
- 5. A Five-minute time limit for each speech will be strictly enforced.
- 6. Speeches will be judged as follows:
 - Content Counts as 1/3 of total score
 - The speaker addressed the topic "What the 4-Way Test Means to Me"
 - Delivery Counts as 1/3 of total score
 - Vocal delivery including rate, volume, pronunciation, and variety; effective eye contact and gestures
 - Organization Counts as 1/3 of total score
 - o Introduction of subject, main points, and conclusions
