Where some of the funds raised by our club goes

We regularly contribute to Disaster Aid Australia by purchasing Family Survival Kits that provide emergency shelter and cooking facilities in such areas as the Philippines.



In the wake of Cyclone Pam in Vanuatu we contributed to a Sky-Hydrant which turns dirty water into portable drinking water using osmotic filters at the rate of 1700 litres/hour.

Our most recent contribution has been to assist with emergency care following the disaster in Fiji.

Our club has supported the eradication of Polio for the last 30 years through the efforts of Rotary International and its Rotary Foundation Fund. It has

recently been joined by the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and other countries including Australia, which has pledged \$100 million.

Rotarians have helped immunize more than 2.5 billion children against polio in

122 countries and has reduced polio cases by 99.9 percent worldwide since the first project to vaccinate children in the Philippines in 1979.
