
October is Vocational Service Month

Also, while we're thanking people, thanks to everyone who helped with the woodworking at Broadmoor on Monday. It's always a good time for a good cause.


Remember our evening at Hofbrauhaus is this Thursday. If you're coming on the Rotary bus, then you'll be meeting at LaMalfa.
