Program: SourcePoint –the new brand

Development Administrator, Mike Miller, introduced Director, Bob Horrocks and Public Relations Administrator, Stephanie Steinbeck, who presented updates on the continuing evolution of SourcePoint. The presentation slides supported the facts that the older population in Delaware County is growing faster than the entire population of Delaware County and these predictions tend to be low to actual numbers. Ages 55 to 69 represents 70% of the older population while the 85+ age group is the fastest growing population, which looks to double by 2030. SourcePoint is a nonprofit entity and fund raising helps these older folks stay in their own home by providing services for them and getting them into a place that is best for them.
