President Garret reminded the club that we are still looking for one board member. He also reported that the club is creating a task force to come up with brain storming ideas for fundraising.

Pieces of Eight Rex Welker won the weekly prize but did not find the white marble.

Did you ever wonder about Pieces of Eight.....What happens to the money raised in the weekly ticket sales?

Tickets are sold each Monday and the winning ticket holder receives the daily payout of 20% of the sales. Then he/she has the opportunity to pull a marble out of the box. If the marble is white then the member wins the Treasure Chest money that has been accumulating. Otherwise, the marble is left out of the drawing box thus increasing the chances for each future drawing.

How the income is split:

- 20% Paid to the daily winner
- 20% To Treasure Chest (accumulates until the white marble is pulled)
- 50% To Scholarship Fund
- 10% To Red Beard's Ransom (Monthly attendance incentives)

The accumulated Treasure Chest as of 8-18-14 has **\$157** and will continue to grow until someone pulls the white marble. Past winners have received amounts from a range of \$52 - \$1,465.
