Warren Hyer, Executive Director of the Central Ohio Symphony presented "Engaging the Community through Music" to emphasize the Symphony's presence throughout Central Ohio. The 36th season had an impressive 14,000 in attendance and 26 community partnerships. Highlights of the coming 37th season include Jaime Morales-Matos 14th season as music director and conductor. Events include Benefit at the Barn, Holiday Concerts, Spring Concerts featuring arias from La Boheme, Triumph over Adversity and, the Summer Solstice Festival.

Mr. Hyer gave an update on their biggest community project to date; The Therapeutic Drumming Project, which supports the courts programs. There has been much publicity about this program in various publications. It has produced 100+ hours in facilitation to the courts and Maryhaven.
