Today's Meeting - Chemical Dependency Epidemic

Last Meeting - Delaware County Hunger Alliance

Brandon Feller convened the meeting with Rex Sprague leading the Club in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Brandon Feller introduced our dual speakers, Nancy Shapiro from the Delaware County Combined Health District and Brad Draper from Lutheran Social Services to discuss the issue of Hunger in Delaware County. Yes, that's right, while much is made of the hunger issue in southeast Ohio and other sparsely populated areas, little is heard of the hungry in a more affluent, densely populated County like Delaware.

Nancy Shapiro informed the Club she and Brad Draper serve on the Hunger Alliance which raises Hunger Awareness in Delaware County. There are 11 Food Pantries in Delaware County including the Delaware County Mobile market. The Alliance also stresses healthy food options and works closely with the Mid-Ohio food bank which leverages food donations by a 7 to 1 ratio so every \$1 donation results in \$7 in food!

Stay tuned for the next big project from the Alliance, establishing a large permanent pantry in Delaware to serve as an on-going "Food Hub".

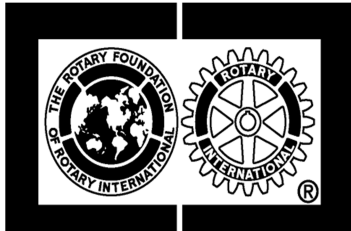

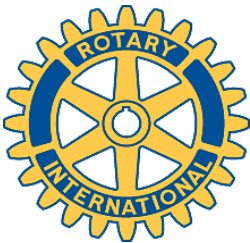
