### **Program Highlights: Mike Dickey, CPA, Partner with Maloney + Novotny**

Frank Rinehart introduced Mike Dickey, Club Member, community leader, and partner in Maloney + Novotny.

Mike began his remarks with a history of the firm, whose predecessors have deep roots in Delaware. Maloney + Novotny now has offices in five Ohio cities: Cleveland, Delaware, Elyria, Canton, and the newest office in Worthington. The firm offers services in the areas of taxes, accounting, auditing, and consulting.

Mike described several key issues facing his clients. These include identity theft and fraud, tax law changes (federal tax law should be stable in 2016, but local taxes are becoming more complicated), record keeping and Quick Books, and changes in the auditing world. Bad players in the commercial world generally lead to new, more complicated auditing rules. Mike gave some suggestions to avoid becoming a victim of identity theft, specifically when e-filing taxes or when contacted by con artists who pretend to be IRS or Treasury agents.

He discussed problems in finding good talent for the firm. He noted that fewer people want to be entrepreneurs by investing in the firm to become partners. He said that most people want to be employees. Also, finding equitable and graceful ways to allow existing partners to retire is never easy.

Mike concluded his remarks with a few well-aged jokes. Most of the Q & A period focused on the identity theft issues Mike had discussed.
