### Program Highlights: Teresa K. Tackett, Judicial Services Manager/Probate Court Investigator, Delaware County Probate/Juvenile Court, on The Court Visitor Program

There are nearly 500 active guardianships currently under the jurisdiction of the Delaware County Probate Court. Guardians are appointed by the Court to have the authority and duty to care for another person or property (the "Ward") due to the Ward's disability or incapacity. The majority of Wards are not seniors; in fact, fewer than 100 of the 500 active case in Delaware County involve Ward who are more than 55 years old. Developmental disabilities are the leading reason for guardianships.

Court Visitors are volunteers who act as the eyes and ears of the Court, visiting Wards to see whether they are receiving appropriate care, that the Guardian is up-to-date with his/her annual reports, and to assist the Guardian and the Ward to connect with community services. Court Visitors physically visit the Ward's residence (home, nursing home, or the Guardian's home) to observe living conditions and ensure the Ward's needs are being met.

Ms. Tackett described the training Court Visitors receive, which includes 8-10 hours in class, then 3-4 joint visits with the social worker before soloing. The goal is to visit every Ward at least once every two years. She asked that members consider volunteering for this program, and then took questions.
