## Today's Meeting – Delaware Hayes Singers

### Last Meeting

President Feller started the meeting with Judge Spicer leading the pledge. Linda Krom introduced our dual speakers whose organizations were the recipients of our Club's 2012 "12 Days of Christmas" proceeds. Jennifer Sami leads **Family Promise** an organization which provides shelter and support to families in need in Delaware and the surrounding area. This inter-faith hospitality group began in 2009 and initially operated out of an office on 35 N. Washington Street. They were forced to leave this year and needed a new facility to operate from. Next door at 39 N. Washington a large 7 apartment unit was vacant but in very poor condition.

Thanks to **Habitat For Humanity** a collaborative effort began between the two organizations. Habitat Director, Todd Miller, had a great power point presentation showing the transformation of 39 N. Washington St. into the new Family Promise facility.

This project was the largest undertaken by Habitat to date encompassing 64 work days, 73 volunteers and 2124.5 work hours. Both organizations are now great friends and now six families can be served on a daily basis. The average length of stay per family is 26 days.

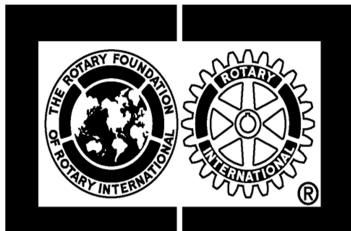
