### **Program Highlights:**

**Joe Pemberton introduced Dr. Richard Bradley and our own Marianne Gabel from the Citizen's Climate Lobby Panel.**

The Citizens Climate Lobby (CCL) is a non-profit, non-partisan, grass roots advocacy group with 385 chapters around the world. The CCL would like people to focus on and talk about solutions to climate change, or global warming, instead of just causes.

### **Global warming symptoms include:**

Drought, wild fires, flooding, water shortages, extreme storms, rising sea levels, and human and plant life being affected by invasive species.

### **CCL's solution includes:**

1. A Carbon Fee and dividend. The fee would be charged at the point of origin of the fossil fuel, like at the coal mine the coal comes from.
2. The Fee would be market based.
3. The revenues collected from the fee would then be re-distributed to each household or family
4. Goods being imported from or exported to a country without a Carbon Fee would have an adjusted fee on those goods.

There are some advantages to charging the Carbon Fee. It would provide an incentive to seek out and develop alternative fuels. This would help create new jobs, grow the economy, and reduce CO2 emissions. The Carbon Fee would be a fair cost spread evenly through the economy. The long-term benefits would be to create high tech jobs, better health for the human population, create 2 million jobs over 10 years, and increase our GDP.

The CCL advisory board includes people like President Reagan's Treasury Secretary George Schultz and members of the World Bank.
