Program Highlights:

Marlene Casini explained the Delaware Rotary Foundation, which is a 501(c)3, therefore tax deductible.

She explained the interaction between the Club and the Delaware Rotary Club Foundation. She then proceeded to outline some of the projects our foundation has participated in and/or funded over the past ten years. Community projects – such as shelters at local parks. 2 - \$1500 college scholarships – Community Grant Requests – up to 2X/yr. – And most recently funded a Turning Point family bedroom/bath at a cost to us of \$12,500 and a matching fund from United Way of Delaware Co. to complete the cost of this room. The current balance of our Delaware Club Foundation is \$16,000 plus investments which are set up to cover scholarships.

Fran Veverka spoke about the District and Rotary International Foundation. We were quizzed to answer the questions of who started the Rotary Foundation – ARCH KLUMPH in 1917 – in CLEVELAND – WITH \$26.50 from the Kansas City Club. And the first donation went to CRIPPLED CHILDREN SOCIETY IN ELYRIA OHIO. When monies are received at the International Foundation they are invested for 3 years before disbursements are made. Fran reviewed some of the types of projects the RI foundation has funded....Health and Human Projects – Water Projects – Literary – Rotary Peace Scholars which also includes Peace and Understanding Group Study Exchanges. On the District Level some of the projects
