**February 17, 2014** – Larry Garrett pitched in for President Brandon.

Alicia Sprau introduced her boss and our guest speaker, Bruce Hagen CEO of the Dublin and Delaware (Grady) branches of Ohio Health. His presentation consisted of 3 parts—1). Ohio Health Update, 2). The Health Care Environment and 3). Grady Update.

The Ohio Health System cares for 2.7 million outpatient services annually, 94,000 in-patient surgeries and ranked in the top 5 of the best Large Health Systems in the country.

Nationally, the Affordable Care Act is an Access Bill that in many aspects provides access to a broken system. Substantive system changes must be led by HC Providers. Bruce stated that change is happening and that progress is being made in Health Care.

Engagement is the key to progress. Ohio Health is now affiliated with MD Anderson—the leading cancer treatment center in the U.S. based out of Houston, TX. Additionally 50 new physicians have been added to the network with Children's Hospital for specialty pediatric care in Delaware. The Delaware Health Center (Glen Road) is now 95% occupied. The future of the DHC holds a number of possibilities including a new hospital location, a free standing ER facility or expanded women's care. It's an exciting time for Ohio Health in Delaware County!!
