### Program Highlights:

Delaware Police Chief Buce Pijanowski and Rev. Tracey D. Sumner Sr., Second Baptist Church presented about the newly formed Delaware Community Coalition. The two gentlemen joined forces for this endeavor about six months ago. Through this coalition their plan is to connect with clergy and build those relationships before something happens in the community. They've been meeting every two weeks and have twelve churches interacting regularly. The goals of the coalition are:

- 1) To have a positive impact on the community
- 2) To improve the future for our children

They are still growing and figuring out how to make it work. Their focus is to manage perceptions and have those hard conversations whereby people are sharing what they really feel. They want to help the city grow positively. Other cities are already reaching out and using the Delaware Community Coalition as a model to form similar programs in their communities.

The coalition plans to add some centrally located basketball courts and have area wide events. They've successfully hosted two services with 350+ in attendance across multiple congregations. Additionally the coffee with cops events have been met with a positive response. They're also working to introduce the organization to individuals as they are being released from jail to offer transportation and other supportive services.
