<u>January 27, 2014</u> Today's Meeting – Board of Regents Chancellor John Carey and OSU President Emeritus Dr. Gordon Gee: "Quality and Value in Higher Education initiative"

<u>January 20, 2014</u> -- President Brandon, who from 2002 to 2008 worked for the American Red Cross, told the story of its founder, Clara Barton (1821-1912) and her Missing Soldiers Office. The "Angel of the Battlefield" for wounded soldiers, she became aware during and after the war that there was no federal service for gathering information about missing and dead soldiers for their families. So she opened her own agency.

In her third-floor apartment and office at 437 Seventh St. in Washington she received 60,000 letters seeking information. She printed and distributed enormous lists of missing/dead soldiers to the public hoping to make connections.

She ended the effort and left the apartment in 1868. After 1911 the site was unused and forgotten, and in 1997 was about to be demolished when a worker found, in the rafters, the sign identifying the site as Barton's Missing Soldiers office. Spared demolition, it is now a museum.
