### **Fast Facts**

There were 2.4 million visitors to the Columbus Zoo and Aquarium last year.

The zoo generates more than \$222 million in economic impact to the region through 275 full time jobs, 2,000 seasonal jobs, gate receipts, day-to-day operational expenses and more.

The Zoo's mission is to lead and inspire by connecting people and wildlife.

Heart of Africa has been wildly popular, leading to a huge spike in attendance.

A new Animal Health Center is on the drawing board. The current center, built in 1990 to serve 2,000 animals cannot handle the present menagerie of 11,000 animals. On average, the team at Columbus Zoo handles "one medical event per hour, per day".

The new center will be the cornerstone of research, pharmacy, pathology, surgery and many other activities related to animal welfare.
