Stephanie DeGenaro is the Program Manager for The Food Protection and Public Safety Unit. This unit is responsible for inspecting facilities where food is sold, investigates food borne illnesses and complaints of unsanitary conditions, conducts plan reviews for new or remodeled food facilities, and educates food workers.

The Food Protection and Public Safety Unit inspects 700 restaurants, grocery stores, vending machine locations and food trucks annually. In 2014 the DGHD investigated 17 possible cases of food borne illness and 63 complaints of unsanitary conditions.

The Food Protection and Public Safety Unit also leads Delaware General Health District's On the Menu program. DGHD's On the Menu is a program targeted at helping Delaware County residents fight the battle against obesity. The DGHD has partnered with area restaurants to help their customers make healthier choices while out to eat. DGHD dietitians have analyzed each menu item, specifically focusing on calories, total fat and saturated fat. Participating restaurants include 12 West, Amato's Pizza, The Delaware County Community Market, OPA, Horsey Hall, Firehouse Tavern, Local Roots, Mi Sombrero, Senor Antonio's, and The Columbus Zoo.
