They had outstanding qualifications and we congratulate them and their families.

Olentangy Rotarian John Madeiros updated us about the El Salvador water project for which the Delaware Rotary Club is the lead contributor. Photo evidence of our funds showed a large cistern that collects rain water for a parched mountain village. (The families of the village had previously hand-dug a deep well that came up dry.)

The plaque on the cistern reads, "El Club Rotario de Delaware."

The cistern filters the water and sends it to a public spigot. John said the cooperation of the local residents in maintaining and sharing the water distribution is unprecedented.

Also part of Rotarian funding is a new village cooperative that has upgraded the quality of hand-made hammocks and brought them to the larger cities where direct sales at higher prices bring in more profit.

Our Invocation was given by George Alexander; Ken Spicer led the Pledge of Allegiance. President Brandon's opening and George's invocation both included our respects to Phil Packard.

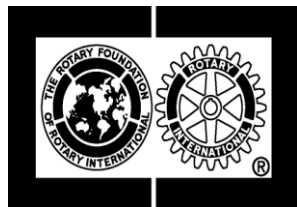

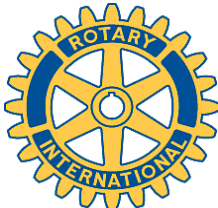
