March 10, 2014 – President Brandon led the meeting and Liz Owens introduced Holly Shellogg from Project SEARCH. Project SEARCH is a one year high school transition program which provides training and education leading to employment for individuals with disabilities. Project SEARCH has programs in 40 states and four countries. Locally Project SEARCH has a partnership between Grady Memorial Hospital/OhioHealth, Delaware Area Career Center, Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities, Ergon Employment Solutions and Delaware County Board of Development Disabilities. Each day a student reports to the host business, learns employment skills in the classroom and job skills while participating in three internship experiences during the year. Students participate in progress meetings to define their career goals and plan necessary steps to achieve that goal. At Grady internship areas include Patient Transport, Nutrition, Nursing Units, Emergency Room, Rehab, Mail Room and Environmental Services. We heard first hand from Nate who described his tasks in his internship rotations. This year there are seven students. Project SEARCH has a goal of 100% student placement in area businesses.
