February 24, 2014

–President Brandon led the meeting and Marianne Gabel introduced OWU Chaplain, Jon Powers. By way of stops at Michigan State University, Adrian College and a BA from Boston College, he is here to “serve as a missionary to the pagan Buckeyes!”

Jon read from notes from his journal to reflect on the chaplaincy duties at Ohio Wesleyan University. He related a story from years back involving Rev. Gordon Cosby and a Spring Break mission team comprised of students of varying backgrounds and upbringings. After a powerful 2 hour session where this diverse team opened up and shared with the venerable theologian, he was quoted as saying, “*There is never an ordinary day in the Chaplaincy.*”

Ohio Wesleyan was founded in 1842 as an Institute of Higher Learning by Adam Poe. An emphasis still exists on the students’ religious journey as, “all are on some kind of journey”. To assist, Jon has a 7 person FT staff and 13 religious life groups on campus and 63 user organizations in Delaware County alone!

Jon dispelled the myth that OWU is a bunch of rich kids from the East and encouraged us to “risk asking questions.” Thanks to all for a memorable presentation.

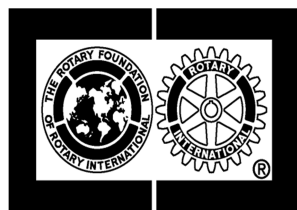
