Last Meeting - John Seager, Population Connection

Marianne Gabel introduced John Seager, President of Population Connection (PC). Maternal and child health is one of Rotary's area of focus, and PC is America's only nationwide population education program, helping teachers to integrate information on population education into the K-12 curriculum. 99% of maternal deaths occur in developing countries, 25 times higher than in developing countries. Seager proffered three "easy" ways to help the problem: birth spacing, delaying the first pregnancy until the mother is physically and mentally ready, and providing contraception. The US plays a dominant role in providing money and leadership to help solve the problems, one of 34 international partners. PC gets its funding from 34,000 private donors (no public funds) and works with 420 educators who volunteer their time to help teachers understand and use the materials that follow state standards.

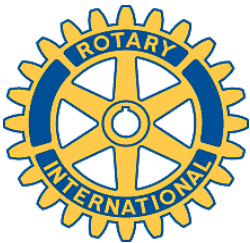
