Tom Curtin, Executive Director  
*Preservation Parks of Delaware County*

*“The mission of Preservation Parks is to protect and conserve Delaware County’s natural, scenic, historic and archaeological features, for the benefit of present and future generation, and to provide enjoyable, safe and accessible outdoor education and recreational experiences for the public.”*



*Curtin talked about several new and outstanding acquisitions. The most recent acquisition is just northeast of Delaware on Pollock Road. **River Run** is another new property north of the city that will allow access to the Olentangy river for kayakers and offer a river trail from Delaware to Highbanks park. **Shale Hollow** off of SR 23 near Orange township just opened last December. Many attendees find the unique geology fascinating. Curtin showed slides of river concretions formed millions of years ago as well as hiking trails and the lodge that is available for group rentals.*

*Future challenges include how to maintain the natural areas and to expand programs. It is hoped that through donations and grants acreage can be acquired, and services expanded by trained volunteers, and college interns without dramatically increasing costs.
