Club Announcements:

- Sheila Hiddelson discussed the upcoming annual meeting and the work done by the Bylaws Committee to review and ensure that the bylaws comply with Rotary International. She turned the discussion over to Rozella Miller who went over the amended bylaws with the club. She pointed out the proposed changes available for club member's review and vote at the November 28, 2016 meeting. She thanked the committee members who helped.
- Joe Evans reminded the members that there is a membership committee meeting after the club meeting. A new member social will take place at OPA restaurant, date and time to be determined later.
- Sheila Hiddelson reminded the club that the board meeting will take place next Monday, 11/14/16, after the regular club meeting due to the Thanksgiving holiday.

Program Highlights:

Alice Sprau introduced Steve Bunyard, president of Ohio Health Grady Memorial Hospital, who gave an update on Grady Memorial Hospital projects. The hospital has been open in Delaware since 1904 and currently has 500 associates at the hospital. Grady has been associated with Ohio Health since 2005. He discussed the various technology upgrades, which include IT integration of communication of electronic medical records. There has also been investment in the Delaware County Area through an increase in health centers, physician practices and hospital access to the Delaware County area.

Grady has seen 25,000 patients through the Emergency Services. Improvements in this area include a more streamline access to larger hospitals and an Electronic Intensive Care Unit, which links to Riverside Hospital for consultations. Grady has also seen newly renovated operating rooms and improved family and patient care areas. Other areas of upgrades have been to Women Health Services and Specialty Care for the Community such as new services and expanded service in Cancer care. Cancer care services include radiation oncology and medical oncology comprehensive care under one roof. Grady is a certified member of the MD Anderson cancer network.

The hospital and its network has received top honors such as a 2015 Top Performer on Key Quality Measures by the Joint Commission and named a 2015 Top Hospital by the Leapfrog Group.
