Mr. Michael Frommer, Director and Ms. Tiffany Maag Deputy Director presented an in-depth analysis of the current state of, and proposed updates, of the Delaware County Regional Sewer District. Plans for investment of sewer infrastructure were reviewed with Master Plan Goals listed. Fast growth patterns are projected for the next ten years, and of course, sewage handling capability has to be at the forefront of that growth. A bar graph showing a rate comparison of our county with others in our central region shows Delaware County with the lowest rates. However, when tap fees and surcharges are compared, we come in near the top end. Our directors have been presenting their plans and messages to several Community Groups, such as BIA and Chamber of Commerce.

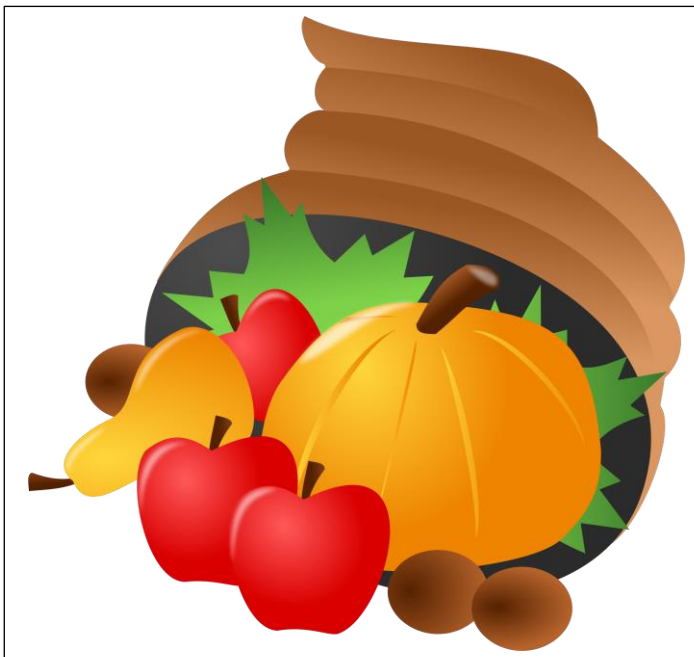
