October 6, 2014 – The Grace Clinic started services in November of 2006 and received its nonprofit status in 2009. The number of patients continues to grow. In September of 2014, they moved to their new location at 40 S. Franklin St. The Grace Clinic provides medical services Wednesday's from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm with specially services such as Chiropractic, Optometry, Nutritionist, GYN, Dental and Physical Therapy being offered once time per month. The clinic relies heavily on the volunteers. On average there are 41 volunteers nightly with a total of 5,021 hours in 2013 to serve the 1,235 patients seen in the clinic. The average value of services provided at each clinic is \$10,147 with an annual total of \$466,762 of all services provided in 2013.
