Program Highlights:

Steve Martin introduced Daniel Griffin and Tony Eyerman from the Evans Farm Land Development Company. Mr. Griffin and Mr. Eyerman spoke about the new Evans Farm Development.

Mr. Griffin began working on the Evans Farm development eight years ago. The Evans family, in developing their farmland, wanted to maintain agricultural values, to continue their environmental stewardship, and to respect the existing communities comprehensive plans.

Evans Farm covers approximately 1100 acres in both Orange and Berlin Townships. The development is a "New Urbanist" development focused on building a community, not just a home. The goal is to create a look and feel of a community similar to those found in Old Westerville, Old Worthington, and Old Delaware. The development integrates home sites with parks, trails, stores, restaurants, ball diamonds, community gardens, a fishing pond, a community center, several schools and a YMCA.

Homes range in price from the low \$300's up to one million. Homes also range in all sizes--from multi-family row houses to large homes. Most homes will have a front porch and the garage is located in the back of the home to contribute to the small town feel of the development.
