Program Highlights: Matt Bruns, District Executive Director for Delaware County YMCA, Jeremy Byers, YMCA Associate Executive Director and Amber Nelson, Senior Membership Director

Matt provided the three pillars that YMCA bases their work upon – Youth Development, Healthy Living and Social Responsibility. Their overall cause is to strengthen community. The YMCA offers sports leagues for youth including basketball for 700 kids, soccer for 700 kids, flag football, tennis. They also provide swim lessons and swim teams. Other programs that are new offerings but going very well is one for adults with chronic disease, the second for cancer survivors and third for healthy weight in childhood. Jeremy discussed the additional youth programs related to art, leadership and summer camps.

Amber stated that the 13000 members all have access to the two indoor pools and the Jack Florence Pool. Members also receive 2 ½ hours free on the rock wall. They have raised \$168,000 in the last twelve months as part of their annual campaign. The Amazing Race is coming up on October 15 and teams of four can register. Funds raised will go to the ten-week program for cancer survivors.
