**September 15, 2014 - Today's Meeting** – Fran Mendez-Exchange Student

**September 8, 2014** – The Hon. Dave Sunderman and Steve Hedge presented the challenges facing Delaware County and the work of the Delaware County Opiate Task Force. They explained why the organization was formed (to combat the high cost of lives lost), who is most at risk (ages 22-55, males twice as likely as females), how users get hooked (often from pain management prescriptions), where users get the drugs (stolen, unused prescriptions and heroin from drug cartel distribution) and why they use them (stimulant, pain block).
