Jennifer Roberts introduced our guest, Dan Sullivan a partner with the HMS Sports Group which runs the Memorial Golf Tournament and from Oct.1-6—The President's Cup at Muirfield. The President's Cup pits the U.S. against the World (Asia, S. America, Australia and Africa) in golf just like the Ryder Cup is the U.S. vs. Europe.

The Muirfield Golf Couse was opened in 1974 and hosted the first Memorial Tournament in 1976. Since then they have hosted the following events: 1987 Ryder Cup, 1992 USA Amateur and 1998 Solheim Cup (Ladies Ryder Cup).

The President's Cup is not the typical stroke play format. Instead Day 1 (Thurs 10/3) Alternating Shot, Day 2 (Fri. 10/4) Foursomes, Day 3 (Sat. 10/5) Four Ball and Sunday (10/6) singles— 12 v.12. The event is slated to bring in \$50 million to our local economy with \$4 million going to charity. Former President Bush is scheduled to attend. Enjoy!


