Fran gave us a brief description about herself, her home, and her experience in the US so far. Fran hails from Talca, Chile, a city with a population of 200,000 and located at the foot of the Andes Mountains, about 80 miles south of Santiago. There, she dances “La Cueca” (a traditional Chilean dance), plays competitive team handball, and enjoys Pastel de Choclo, a traditional Chilean desert. Since coming to Delaware, she has enjoyed her travels to Michigan and the Delaware County Fair and participating on Delaware Hayes Cross Country team. Fundraising Committee

Mike Miller announced the progress made in preparation for the Delaware Rotary Club’s the annual **12 Days of Christmas** fundraiser. Tickets will be available for members to pick up and sell or purchase beginning November 3rd. The club is asking that each member sell or purchase tickets in the amount of \$100 or more per member. Tickets will be sold at face value of \$5 per ticket or 3 for \$10. Daily drawings will be held December 12-23rd.

Mike also discussed the recent **fundraising survey** that was sent out again this week. The survey received responses from 52% of the members. Key findings include: membership preference for club run fundraisers (as opposed to partnering), a goal for our annual fundraiser of \$10k or more, and emphasis on communicating to the public efforts to raise funds for local organizations that support the eradication of hunger and poverty and other international causes. The committee suggested that each club member consider volunteering between 6-10 hours in support of fundraising for these causes.
