**September 29, 2014 - Today's Meeting** – Mr. Tom Hall, Polio Plus

**September 22, 2014** – District Governor, Mr. Randall Davies provided an overview of District 6690 and the goals and activities that have been established in support of Rotary International President, Gary C.K. Huang's theme of "Light Up Rotary". Working together, the District Governors have settled on three goals. The first, "Increasing Membership", will be supported by encouraging efforts within each club to achieve an increase of at least 100,000 new members in 2015. The second goal of "Improving Awareness and Public Image" will be supported by initiatives that will promote the activities and the public good that Rotary Clubs contribute to their communities at home and around the world. One such initiative will be to create a Facebook page highlighting stories from local Rotary Clubs that are impacting over a thousand communities and over a million lives. A third goal remains "Accomplishing the Eradication of Polio through the work of the Rotary International Foundation." With only four countries left where new Polio infections have been documented, it is believed that 2015 can be the year when this goal is finally accomplished. It will be difficult, but if the last case of polio is documented in 2015 and can be sustained until 2018, it is believed that eradication of the disease will be confirmed. Mr. Davies concluded by inviting all club members to attend the District Conference/Retreat to be held October 10-11 at Shawnee Lodge in Portsmouth, Ohio.
