Last Meeting - Rock Jones OWU Update

Brandon Feller convened the meeting with Judge Spicer leading the Club in the pledge. Jennifer Roberts, Director of Annual Giving at OWU, introduced our speaker, Ohio Wesleyan University President Rock Jones a community leader who “inspires progress”.

Rock gave an informative and entertaining talk about the importance of a liberal arts education in today’s economic environment as well as the challenges facing universities today. When talking to potential OWU students, Rock asks them two questions, “What vocation will they have when they are their parents’ age?” and “What technologies will they be using?” These are challenging questions given the speed of change in which we operate today. OWU addresses these challenges by growing leaders through emphasizing critical thinking and communications skills and considering complex problems from multiple perspectives.

President Jones then switched gears and talked about some exciting changes and upcoming events on campus including an \$8 million donation to upgrade Merrick Hall which has been vacant for 30 years, the joint project to upgrade The Strand Theater, and the world premiere of the theater production of theater production of **The Secret War of Emma Edmunds** in 2 weeks.

Rock ended his presentation by giving a real life example of a current OWU student (and future leader) Tyler Sheets who excels in the class room, on the football field and on stage!

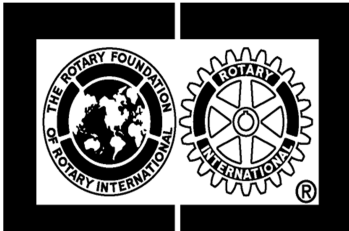

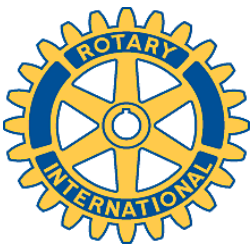
