- Program Highlights: Sandy Kuhn, Delaware County Fair General Manager and Ron Potter, Delaware County Harness Racing
- Sandy Kuhn, the Delaware County Fair Manager, was formerly with the Farm Bureau for 9 years and has a background in Agriculture, Business and Human Resources. She opened up her discussion with some quizzes about the Fair, a long time tradition here in Delaware. Some of the completed projects at the Fairgrounds include a new landscaping project and work under the grandstands includes renovations to the women's restrooms and additional televisions added. The fair begins Saturday, September 17, 2016 and runs through Saturday September 24, 2016.
- Ron Potter, from Croton Ohio, not only worked at Nestle for 25 years, but has also been a horse trainer for 45 years. He trained the 2011 Little Brown Jug winner, Big Bad John, winning over a one million dollar purse. He explained the training process from purchase of a yearling through breaking and training of the horses. This takes a lot of time and involves a large support system of blacksmith, stables and veterinarians. Usually the trainers know within 3 months the type of athlete the horse is and they can race into the fourth year, after which time they go to stud.
