  - b. Determine locations/areas of responsibility
    - (1) Beck Lake Bike Path
    - (2) Shoshone River Bike Path
    - (3) Beck Lake "Beach" with defined swimming area
    - (4) Shoshone River Kayak Park with artificial waves, orienteering course

### 2. Medicine on Wheels Project

- a. Meet with other interested parties regarding needs assessment
