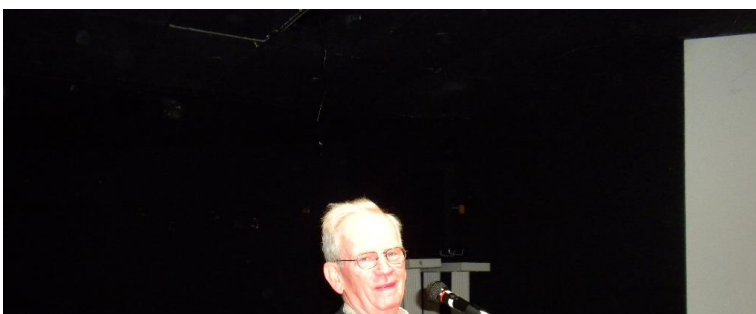

Meeting Notes
