Disaster Relief for Ukraine

Contributions to the Disaster Relief Fund in support of Ukraine can be made at: https://my.rotary.org/en/disaster-response-fund

All funds need to be received into the Disaster Response Fund by 30 April 2022 in order to qualify for use in support of the Ukrainian relief

These expedited disaster response grants can be used to supply water, food, medicine, shelter, and clothing.

As of today (March 31, 2022) contributions for the Ukrainian Relief Response are \$12,101.

This includes \$1,400 from non-rotarians but does not include \$5,000 in matching funds from our Foundation reported Longley Parker, Rotary Club Treasurer.
