“Water Project in Yakunay Ecuador“ with Scott Thompson

Kellie Thompson was a member of Interact while attending high school and re-established the Rotaract program, serving as the President, while completing her degree in Bio-medical Science at Colorado State University. She attended many Rotary programs while at CSU and was able to participate on a Rotary mission trip to help the residents of Gualan, Guatemala. Her experiences during this mission trip inspired her to volunteer for the Peace Corps where she has been serving in Ecuador since May of 2009. During her stay Kellie discovered the small community of Yakunay that had an antiquated water system that was badly in need of expansion and repairs. Kellie teamed up with Rotary Clubs in Estes Park, Fort Collins and Riobamba, Ecuador, the local community and Engineers Without Borders to raise funds and complete the first phase of this water project in January 2012. Although her term with the Peace Corps ends this month, she hopes that the next phase of this water project can be completed through the cooperation of the community of Yakunay, The Rotary Clubs of Estes Park, Fort Collins and Riobamba, Ecuador.
