- 4:30 - 7:00 - Dishwashers - need 2

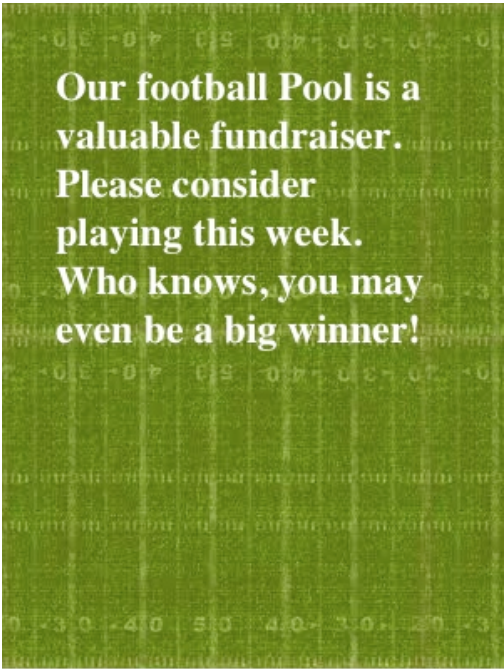
In the dining room
