This program falls under Larimer County Dept of Health and Environment and answers the question from the Governor regarding prevention programs using marijuana retail tax dollars. Forty-six communities in the state have picked up this funding.

Dr. Murthy has expertise with Rotary international Global Grants, and he highlighted two that helped the Dr. M.C. Modi Eye Hospital in India. Through cooperation with local clubs, District 5440, RI, and clubs in India, Dr. Murthy was able bring \$150,000 to the hospital to help with eye exams and procedures for patients unable afford quality eye care.
