Jim Whiteneck announced the unfortunate passing of Howard Marco, a longtime member. There will be a memorial service on June 25 at 11:00 at St. Marks.

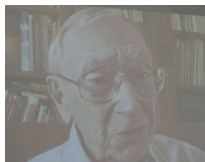
Scott Thompson told his joke to good effect.
